



VISIT 1 - Guarda Rios on the Rio Grande and its tributaries

Start at Praia da Areia Branca, with a presentation of the project, then head to the village of Lourinhã (exact location to be agreed), with the aim of getting to know how the activity works and its results.

VISIT 2 - The West Geopark Biodiversity

Lagoa de Óbidos and Paúl da Tornada (transport included)

Start from one of the recently installed birdwatching stations and walk along the shores of Óbidos Lagoon. There are three new Biological Bird Observatories at Óbidos Lagoon, all of which have information panels on the waterbirds of Óbidos Lagoon, with data from the Bio Lagoa de Óbidos project, a partnership between Óbidos Municipality, Águas do Tejo Atlântico and the PATO Association, and the ornithologist Hélder Cardoso. This is followed by a visit to the Paul de Tornada Ecological Educational Centre and to the trail and observatories of the Paul de Tornada Local Nature Reserve, to discover an important wetland that has been classified as a Ramsar Site and is part of the National Network of Protected Areas. The Reserve is managed by Caldas da Rainha City Council, in close collaboration with the Institute for Nature Conservation and Forests and the Environmental Non-Governmental Organisations GEOTA and Associação PATO.

#### VISIT 3 - Torres Vedras coastal route

Assenta Beach, Foz do Sizandro Beach and Santa Cruz (transport included)

Learn about the coastal and marine biodiversity of an exceptional area in the municipality of Torres Vedras, as well as the project to recognise this area as a Local Nature Reserve. There will also be an opportunity to learn about the crafts of the fishermen, the unique fossil remains and the visitor infrastructure installed in strategic locations. In Santa Cruz, the implementation of the ISO 13009:2015 standard (Tourism and related services - Requirements and recommendations for operating on a beach) will be presented in the support facilities at the Centre and Física beaches, as a way of guaranteeing the reconciliation of the provision of a quality service with the principles of environmental sustainability. The values of coastal communities will also be shared, with a presentation of the activities of the Sealand Association.
